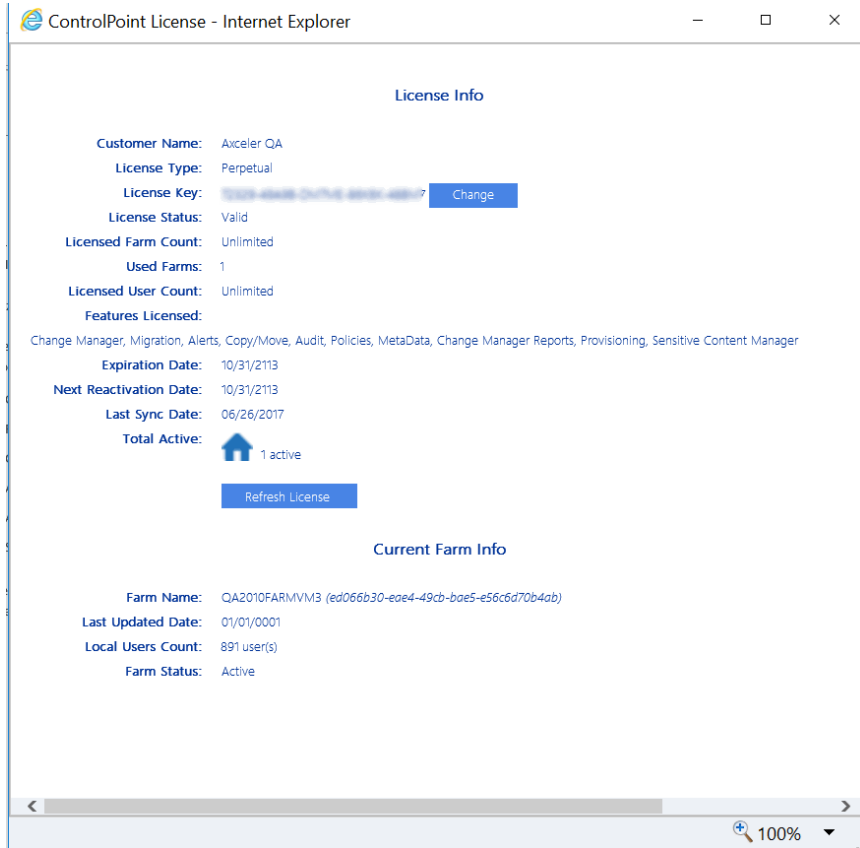

The Checked Out Documents analysis lets you identify all currently checked-out documents within a selected scope, regardless of *when* they were checked out.



## Sensitive Content Manager Enhancements

When defining a ControlPoint Policy to scan items for sensitive content, you can choose a profile to use for the scan.

## Miscellaneous Enhancements and Bug Fixes

- It is no longer necessary to run ControlPoint Discovery in order to generate Audit Log analyses
- For Activity analyses, a new ControlPoint Setting—Use Minimum Activity Date as Start Date—allows you to override the check that ControlPoint performs to ensure that you have not entered a Start Date that precedes the oldest record of activity retained in the database, resulting in faster page load times.
