### **New Features in ControlPoint for Office 365**

#### **Support for Sensitive Content Manager Server**

For the multitude of users concerned with security in their SharePoint Online environment, ControlPoint has offered integration with Sensitive Content Manager as a Cloud Service. As more and more Clients find a need to retain all sensitive scanning in an on-premises environment or a secure private cloud, Metalogix released an on-premises version of Sensitive Content Manager titled Sensitive Content Manager Server. This release represents the available integration of this system and ControlPoint for Office 365, allowing users to continue to leverage the Microsoft Cloud for the storing of content, yet processing the sensitivity analysis can continue on-premises.

#### **Scheduled Reports for Site Admins**

As part of the benefits of delegated administration that are generated by ControlPoint, one sticking point has been the ability to define a Site Administrator and identify them as a user or the target of a distributed report. In this release this feature has been expanded to ControlPoint for Office 365 – scheduled reports can now be automatically distributed to the defined iteration of a “Site Admin”.

### **New Features in ControlPoint for SharePoint 2010 and SharePoint 2013 On-Premises**

#### **Improvements for Discovery with Orphaned Users**

As environments continue to grow and turnover in these environments continues, the [number](#) of users who are no longer active expands over time. In an effort to improve overall Discovery performance, these users are now being excluded from the Discovery process. This does not reduce the reporting capabilities of orphaned accounts, but instead reduces the Discovery time in environments with a significant amount.

#### **Improved Orphaned User Clean-Up**

One of the benefits ControlPoint provides is the option to identify and clean-up Orphaned Users in the SharePoint environment. This can improve performance, provide better identification, and facilitate business continuity. Previously ControlPoint only provided the option to clean-up Orphaned Users associated Alerts and MySites when performing this removal action manually. In an effort to facilitate a more automated process for environmental clean-up, ControlPoint can now remove the Users, the MySites, and the Alerts as a single action.
